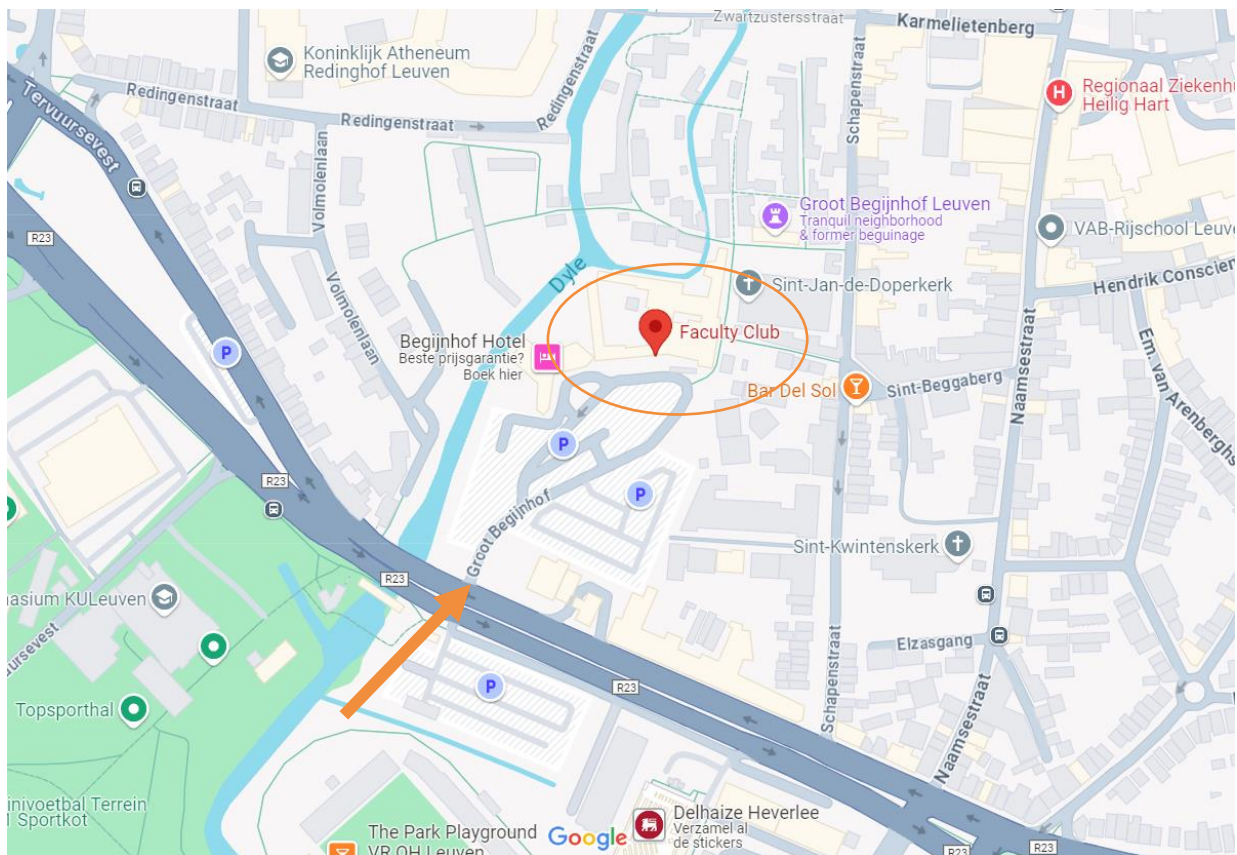

How to get there?

By train

Take the train to station LEUVEN

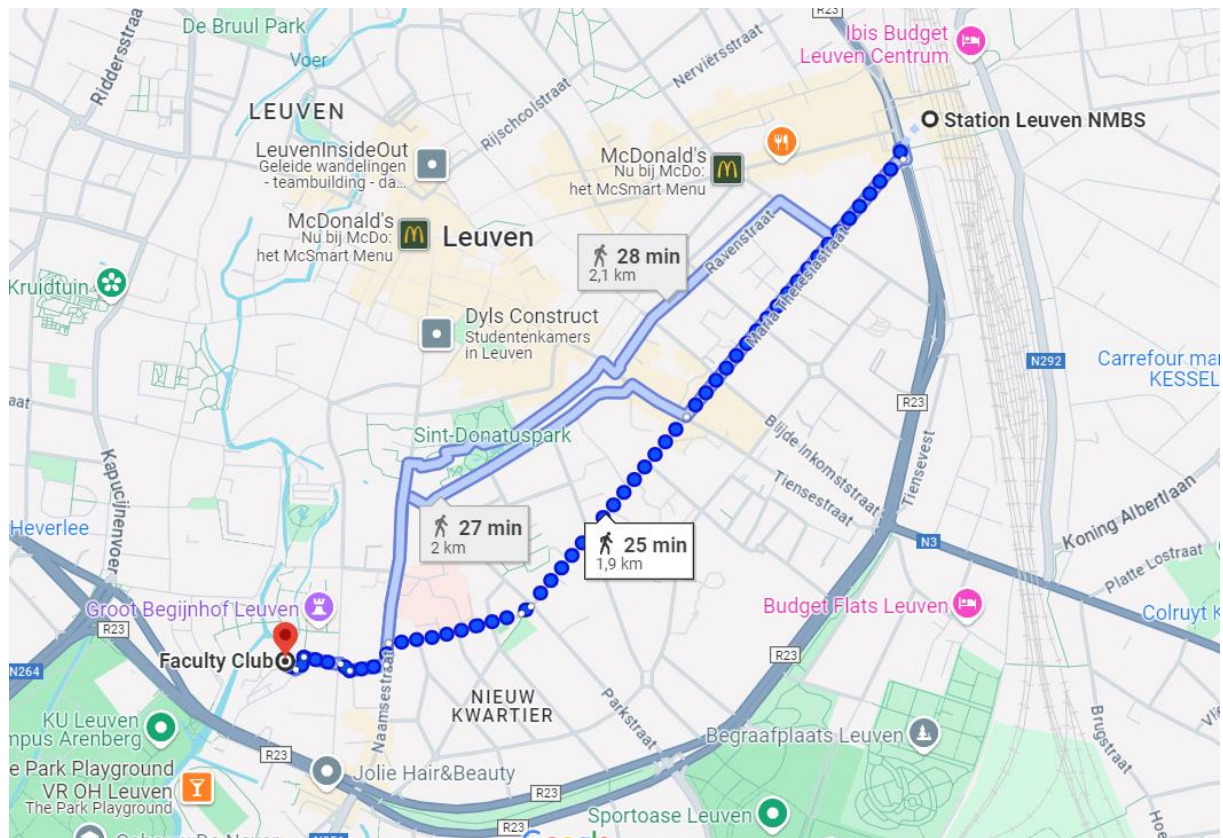
Go towards the front of the train station “Martelarenplein”

From the front of the train station, you can take a bus or go by foot.

On foot

This is a 1.9km walk.

Walk across the train station to Maria Theresiastraat. Follow all the way until the intersection with Parkstraat. Go straight on, towards Hendrik Consciencestraat. At the end, go left on Naamsestraat and immediately on the first intersection, go right on Sint-Beggeborg. Stay right on Sint-Beggeborg until the intersection with Schapenstraat. Cross Schapenstraat and go into the Groot Begijnhof, a very small street which will bring you all the way to the Faculty Club.

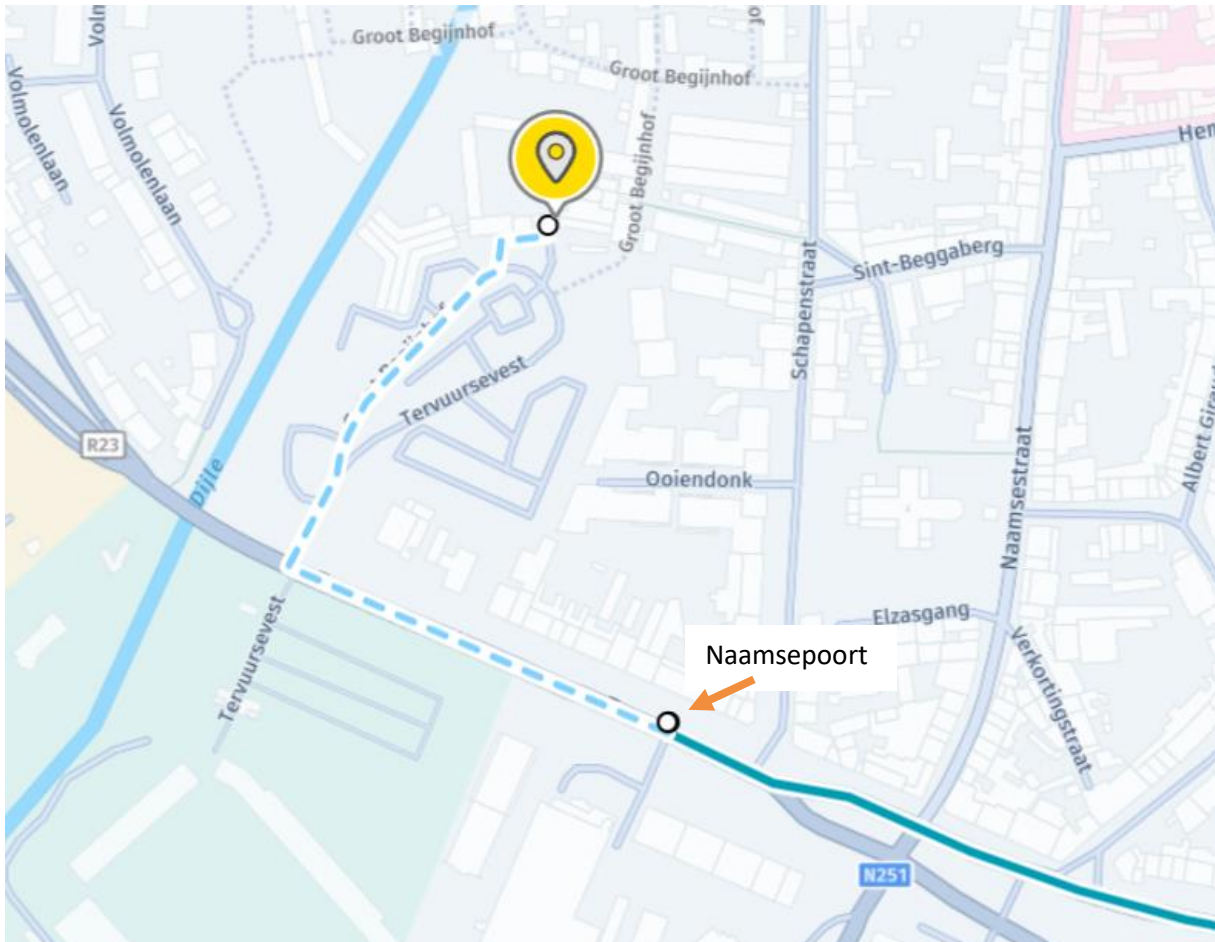


By bus

Take the bus to busstop “Naamsepoort”. Possible busses: **601**, 616, 13, 2, 537, 79, 600 (although 601 is better)

By car

If you use Waze or Google Maps as GPS, it knows where “Faculty Club Leuven” is.

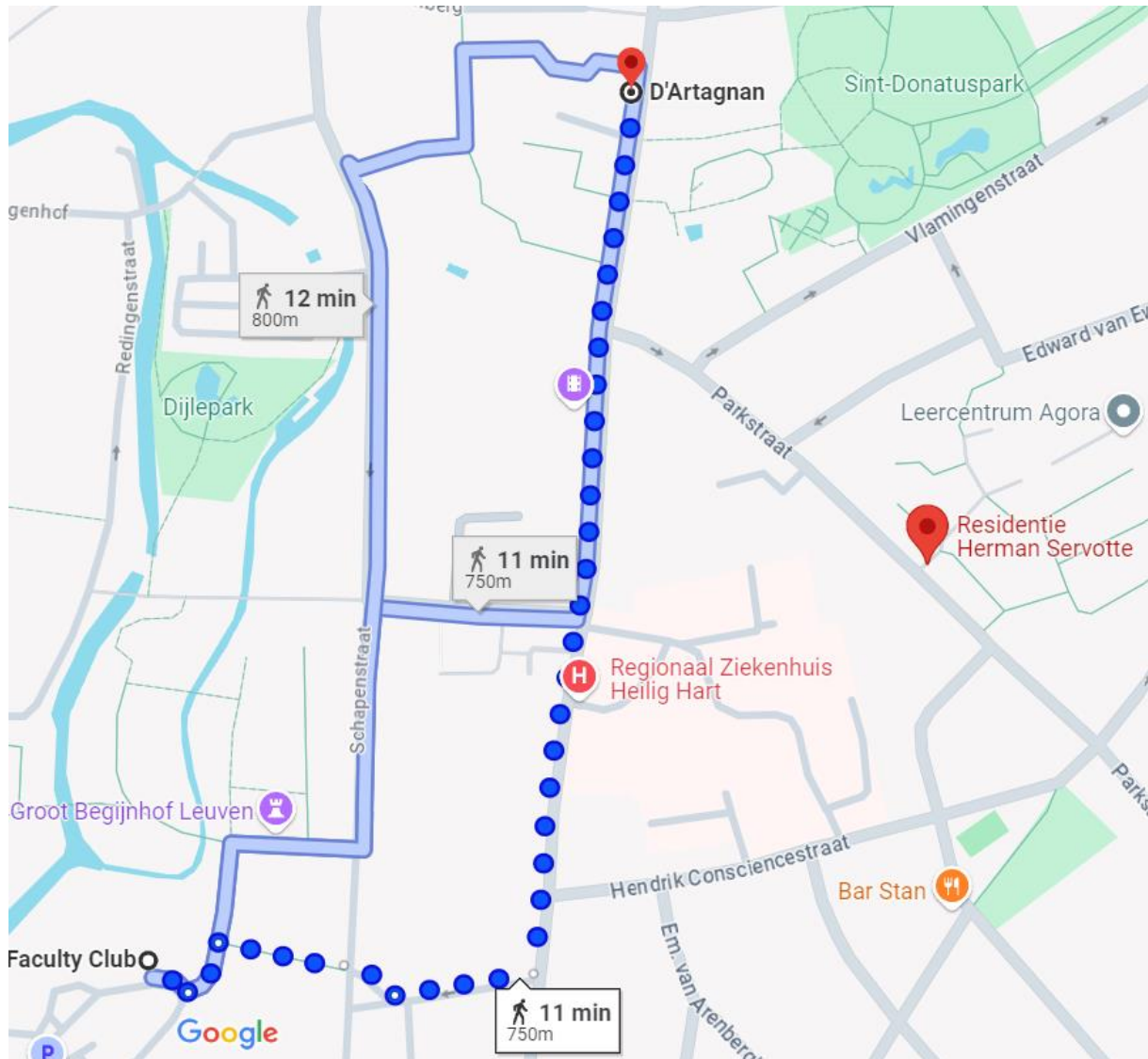
There is only 1 way from the ringway to enter Groot Begijnhof, so it is possible you have to pass it and turn around to drive back a little.

There is free parking in front of Faculty Club (P2/P3) with parking code **5449#**.

How to get to the conference dinner?

It's only 750 meter from the Faculty Club towards the restaurant. We would like to advise you to do this on foot.

The address is: Restaurant d'Artagnan; Naamsestraat 72, 3000 Leuven.



If you are unable to go by foot, you can park your car in the underground parking Herman Servotte, Parkstraat 39/41 using the free entrance code **18851#**

Parking in the city center is always to be paid. Please be careful driving in the city center, as not all streets are accessible for cars. Those streets have camera surveillance and they will send you a fine if you drive there.
